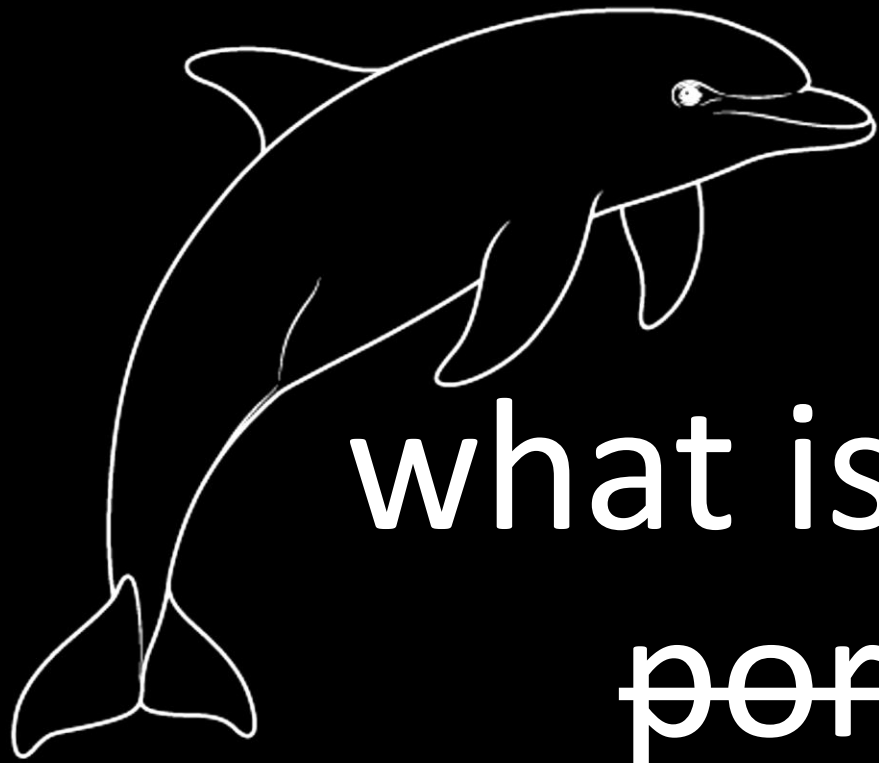

- but... you can go backwards


giving our lives away

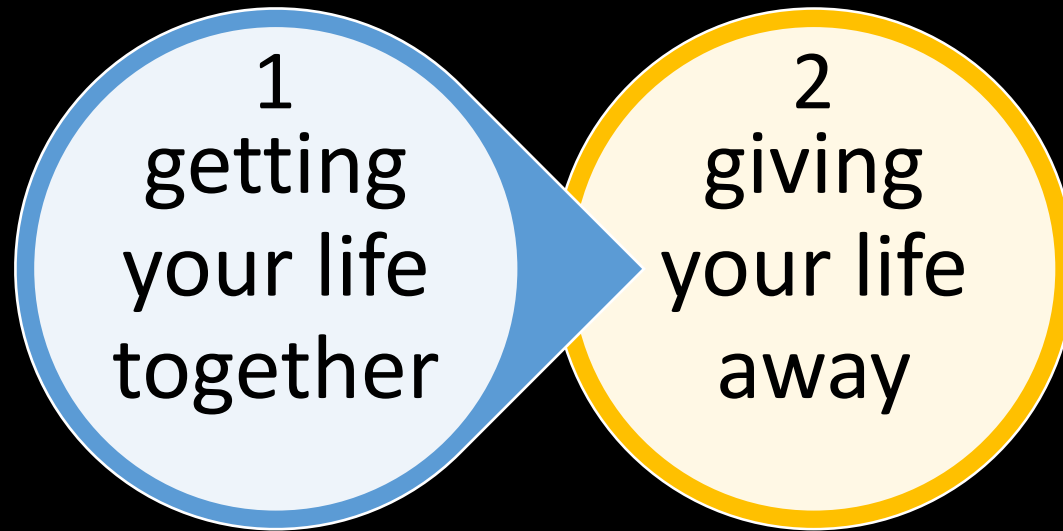

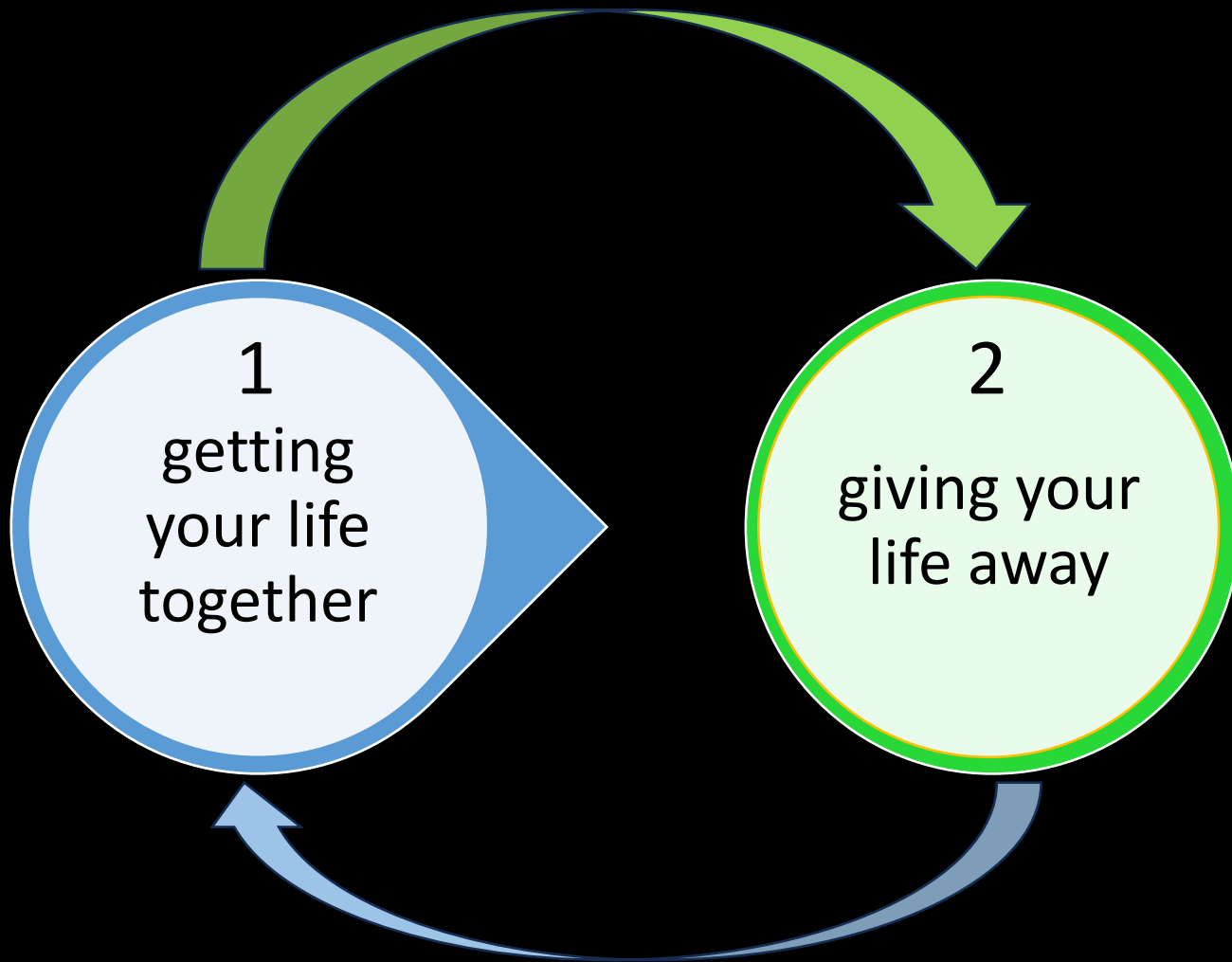

'states'/stages of life



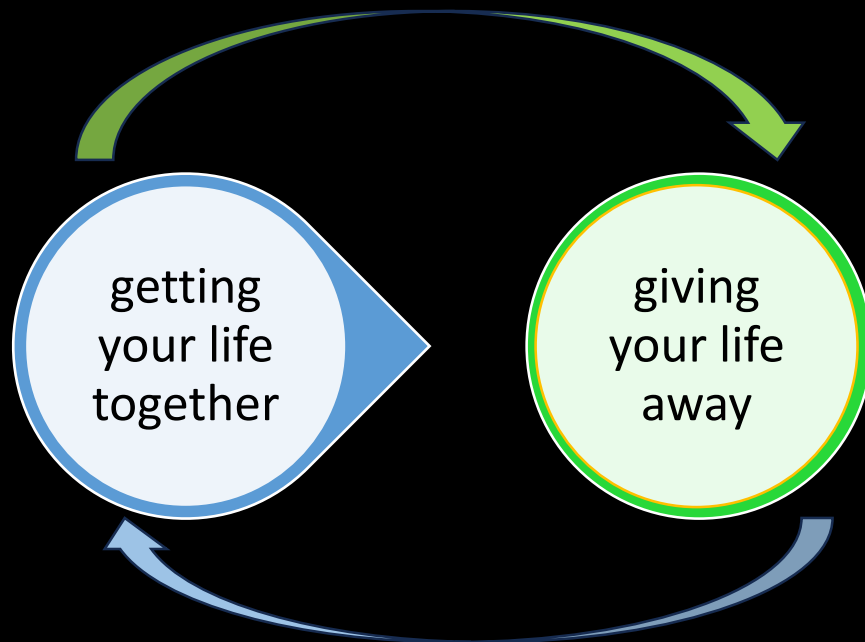
