





#### Sowing

But those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires.






### Sowing

What do we set our minds on?


Either we sow to the **flesh**Our selfish desires





**Time + Intentionality** 



Time + Intentionality = Growing






#### Matthew 3:17



<sup>19</sup> The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; <sup>20</sup> idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions <sup>21</sup> and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.



<sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness and self-control.








