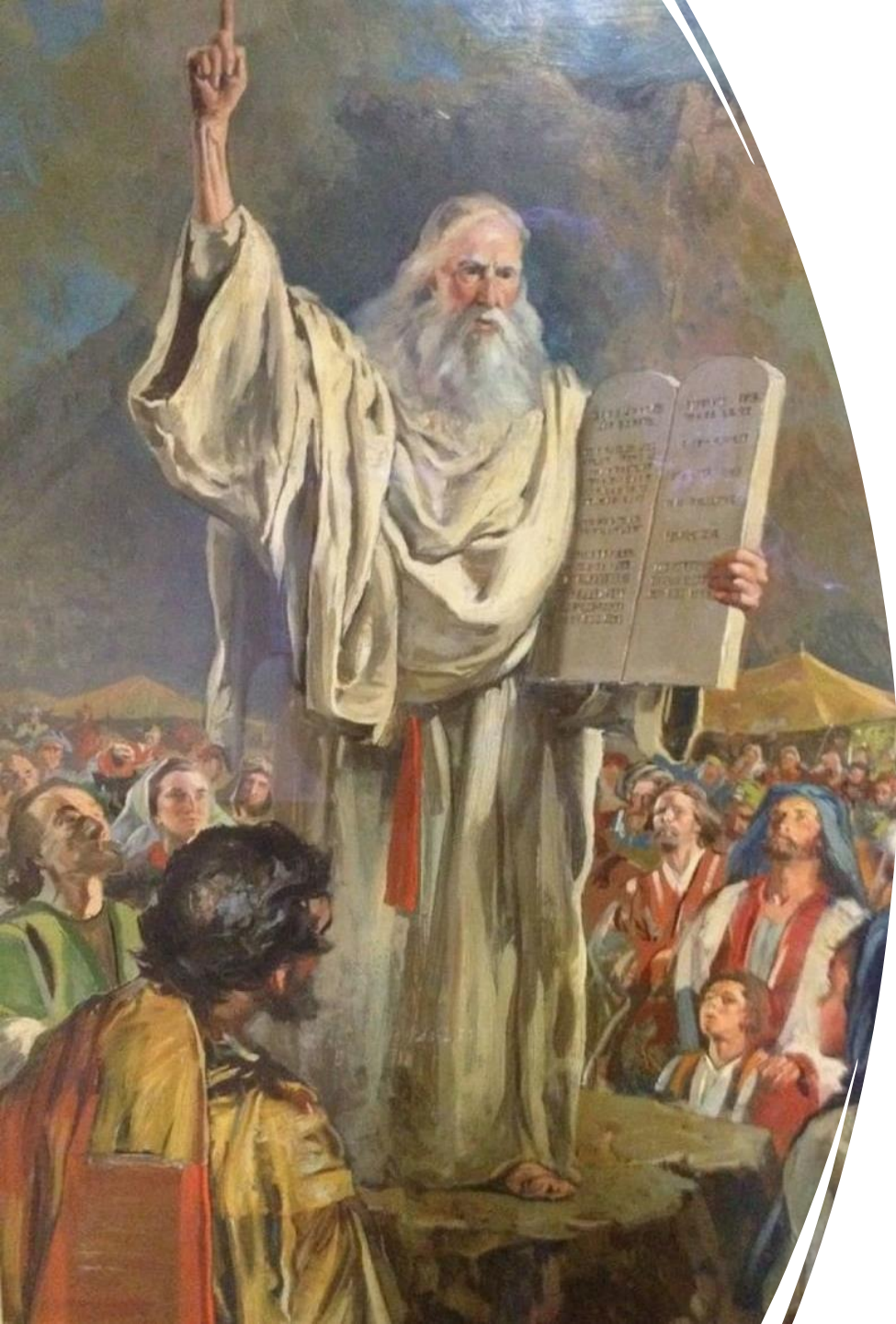




Worship God His Way

"Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah. Offer him there as a burnt offering."





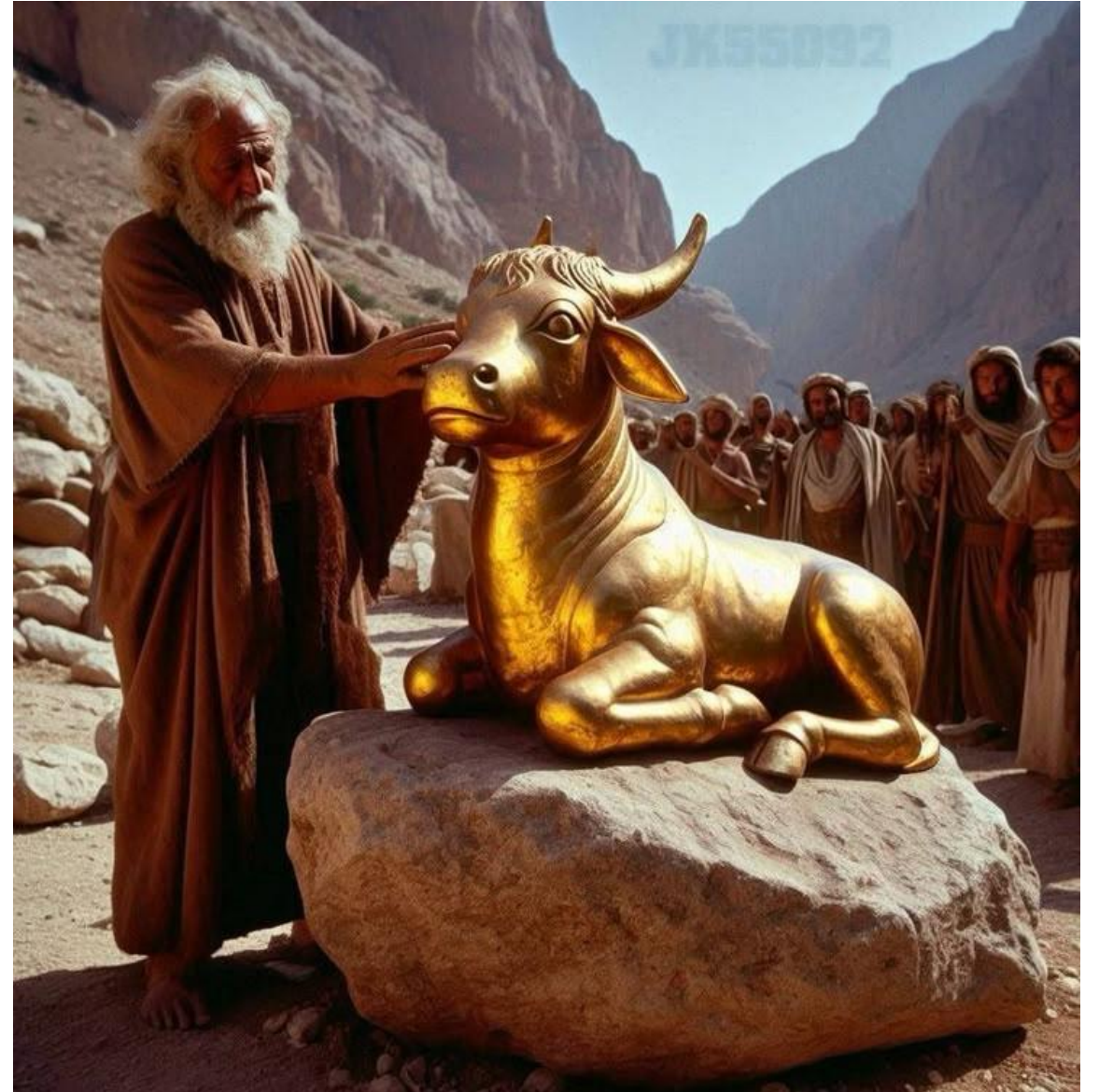
“Does it matter how we worship?”

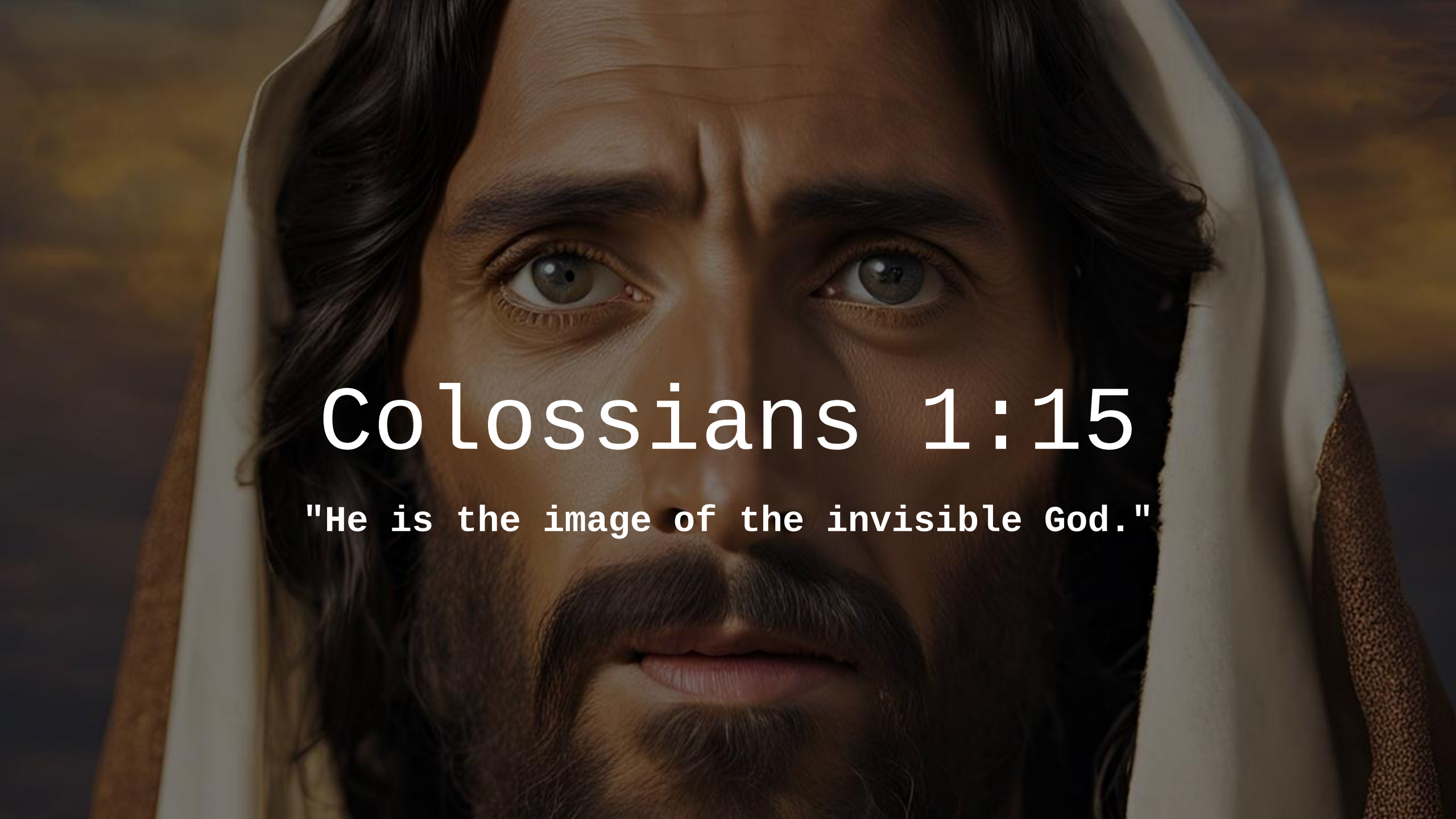
**"You and your sons and daughters, your male and female slaves, and the Levite who is within your city gates, since he has no portion or inheritance among you." —
